





DAY 2 Echmiadzin, Genocide Memorial

DAY 3 Khor Virap, Noravanq, Stepanakert

Khor Virap is the well where St. Gregory the Illuminator was imprisoned for 13 years by an Armenian king for preaching Christianity. **Noravank** is a 13th century monastery located on the edge of a canyon of astounding beauty. **Zorats Qarer** is the name given to the Armenian "Stonehenge". **Stepanakert**, the capital of Nagorno Karabakh, is a beautiful green city nestled within a bowl of mountains.





DAY 4 Gandzasar, Shoushi

Gandzasar Monastery is in the northern part of Nagorno Karabakh, surrounded by mountains and forests. The Bishop of Gandzasar traditionally was the head of the church in Karabagh. The City of **Shoushi** was the center of Nagorno Karabakh and was one of the biggest and important cities in Southern Coucasus in 19th century.

DAY 5 Tatev, Jermuk, Yerevan

One of the masterpieces of Medieval Armenian Architecture is the **Tatev Monastery**, which is circa 1000 years old. It is located on the right bank of Vorotan canyon and is connected with the left bank by the longest cable car in the world. **Jermuk**, which is situated in the gorge of the Arpa River, is the most famous spa resort in Armenia. The elevation is more than 2000m above sea level. It's famous hot springs attract many people for treatment and recreation.





DAY 6 Garni, Geghard

Garni is a Hellenistic style pagan temple built in the 1st century A.D. **Geghard** is a 13th century cave monastery where the holy lance that pierced the body of Christ was kept.

DAY 7 Sevan, Haghartsin

Lake Sevan is one of the few large lakes in the world at a high altitude of 1900m above sea level. There is a fantastic view over the lake from the Monastery of Sevan built in the 9th century. **Haghartsin** is a 13th century monastery located near the resort town of Dilijan.

DAY 1 Arrival in Yerevan, City Tour

One of the biggest collections of manuscripts in the world is kept in the **Matenadaran** Institute-Museum. Also visit the **Winers' Association of Armenia.**



DAY 2 Echmiadzin, Sardarapat, Map winery



In the year 301 A. D. Armenia became the first official Christian country in the world. The **Echmiadzin Cathedral** has been the religious centre of all Armenians for 17 centuries. In 1918 the young Armenian army and militia managed to stop the Turkish army at the **Sardarapat Battle** Field though the quantity of Turkish troops was much larger. The **MAP winery** was founded in 1942. The whole cycle of wine and brandy making is based on classical technologies. Dinner is organized at the Armenian Unity Cross.

DAY 3 Areni Winery, Noravank

The **Areni Winery** is a young winery in Vayots Dzor region.

The majority of their products are exported to Russia. **Noravank** is a 13th century monastery located on the edge of a canyon of astounding beauty.



DAY 4 Garni, Geghard, Yerevan Cognac Factory



Garni is a Hellenistic style pagan temple built in the 1st century A.D. **Geghard** is a 13th century cave monastery where the holy lance that pierced the body of Christ was kept. **ARARAT brandies** are produced by **Yerevan Brandy Company**. ARARAT is the most famous and successful brand of Armenian brandy in the world. Dinner is served in the Ararat Hall, with a live demonstration in Armenian cooking.

DAY 5 Dilijan, Haghartsin, Sevan

Haghartsin is a 13th century monastery located near the resort town of **Dilijan**. **Lake Sevan** is one of the few large lakes in the world at a high altitude of 1900m above sea level. There is a fantastic view over the lake from the Monastery of Sevan built in the 9th century. Dinner is served with fish.



DAY 6 Armenia Winery, Perch Proshyan's Museum, Saghmosavank, Qursi

"Armenia Wine" is the largest Armenian winery. The factory produces Armenian wine as well as cognac and vodka, and has it's own array of vineyards.



DAY 7 Genocide Memorial, Noy Winery, Tumanyan Pandok, Matenadaran, Farewell party at Afrikyan's Pandok


On the Tsitsernakaberd Hill the **Genocide Memorial** was erected in 1967 to commemorate the victims of the Armenian Genocide. The most unique and largest collection of manuscripts are displayed in the **Matenadaran Museum.**
